# 1. Schedule a Free Home Energy Audit

- The City's energy auditor will check your attic to determine its existing insulation level, square footage and insulation amount (R-values) to be added.
- Your energy auditor will provide a list of qualified installing contractors.
- The energy auditor will complete your Customer Agreement form, showing exact costs. You sign the form and keep two copies – one for yourself and one for your installing contractor.

- Have your Agreement form in hand when you call a contractor to make an installation appointment. The contractor will need to know the attic square footage indicated on the form and R-value to be added.
- All participating contractors install blown fiberglass or loose-fill cellulose at \$0.035 per R-value per square foot, as shown by your energy auditor's calculation.

# Grant Details

## 80% Grant to \$400:

- The City of Tallahassee Utilities pays 80% of the installed cost up to \$400, calculated at \$0.035 per R-value per square foot.
- The insulation target level is R-38 (R-49 if residence is heated with electric resistance).
- This grant is available to all City of Tallahassee electric customers in residences that are owned or rented (detached, duplex, triplex or quadraplex).

## Income-Based Grant to \$500:

- The City of Tallahassee Utilities pays 100% of the installed cost up to \$500, calculated at \$0.035 per R-value per square foot.
- The insulation target level is R-38 (R-49 if residence is heated with electric resistance).
- This grant is available to qualified City of Tallahassee Electric customers, based on specific income levels, in residences that are either owner-occupied or rented (detached, duplex, triplex or quadraplex).
